

What is an Authority?

Authorities are governmental bodies created to finance and/or operate specific public works projects (i.e. water, wastewater, stormwater, solid waste, transportation, parking, etc.) without tapping the general taxing powers of the municipality. An authority can be organized by any county, city, borough, incorporated town, township or school district of the Commonwealth and are established under the Municipality Authorities Act (53 Pa.C.S.Ch.56) or the Parking Authority Law (53 Pa.C.S.Ch.55). It is estimated that more than 2,600 municipal authorities exist in the Commonwealth.

Purpose:

The purpose of this scholarship is to increase knowledge and awareness of authority service and the need for qualified employees in the industry. Authorities operate with employees trained in business, management, operations and the trades with authority service areas including, but not limited to, public water, wastewater, stormwater, solid waste and recycling, airports, transportation, parking, redevelopment, emergency/medical, recreation, etc.

Award:

Scholarship(s) at a minimum of \$1,000 and up to \$3,000 each will be announced for recipient(s) by the end of April 2024. Recognition of winner(s) will formally occur at the 2025 PMAA Annual Conference in September or another predetermined PMAA event.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Applicant must be a student enrolled in a high school, technical school, undergraduate or graduate college or university,
OR
an employee of a PMAA member municipal authority pursuing continuing education or credentialing/certification and with less than two years of employment in the industry.
- The scholarship may be used for education-related expenses such as tuition, books, or enrollment/registration fees for professional development or credentialing coursework.
- The scholarship may not be used to cover stipends or wages.
- Previous applicants may reapply in subsequent years as long as they meet eligibility requirements above.

Selection Criteria:

- Present clarity of goals and objectives as outlined via a personal essay. Include how your field of study, continuing education, credentials or future pursuits would pertain to the work of an authority. Illustrate your understanding of the structure and work of municipal authorities and the impact they have on the community.
- Include a resume showing interest in or pursuit of a field of study related to authority service and/or interest in entering the industry.
- Provide a plan for use of the scholarship funding.

Application Procedures:

- Application must be submitted with the following:
 - A Personal Essay (to include goals/objectives, how the scholarship will be used to attain future goals, and your understanding of authority service);
 - A Resume (to include community involvement, internships and other experiences); and,
 - A minimum of one letter of recommendation.
