North Penn Water Authority (NPWA) is well-established and provides on-the-job training. Prior related experience, such as HVAC, plumbing or electric is a bonus.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Completes water quality sampling according to NPWA's SOPs, and in compliance with the DEP and all local, state, and federal regulations.
- Utilizes SCADA software to monitor, regulate, analyze, and operate the water distribution system.
- Installs, repairs, and performs routine maintenance of mechanical, electrical, electronic-regulated systems, equipment, instrumentation, and other apparatus associated with water production, storage, and operation facilities.
- In addition to regularly scheduled hours, works after-hours to perform remote system monitoring and respond to emergency repairs. This is a rotating schedule and includes remote monitoring and on-call responsibilities every 3rd weekend.
- Performs basic facility maintenance which includes miscellaneous and routine building, plumbing, HVAC, and electric maintenance and repair, as well as mowing and property upkeep.
- Performs all other duties as necessary.

Qualifications and Skills

- Valid driver's license with a clean driving record.
- High school diploma or equivalent.
- General troubleshooting skills.
- Comfortable learning and using technology.
- Prior applicable experience in water, HVAC, or plumbing industry preferred.
- Physically mobile with good balance.
- Ability to lift and carry/push/pull a minimum of 75 pounds.
- Ability to work in confined spaces, climb ladders or scaffolding, frequent standing and bending.
